Now that the club is up and running, we are returning a section of it to Rocky Mountain. We will retain responsibility of 512 on the south side of Studmill, while they will reassume it going north from Studmill. This was coordinated with Eric Sprague from the State.

He assured us tht he would actively participate by contacting AFM to get trails previously removed for logging (which is now done) re-opened. Eric was not positive that he would be successful. We talked to him about the following trails:
  - a. The 511 series
  - b. The 508 bypass
  - c. Extension of 512 to Molasses Pond and then westbound to 510
- d. Extension of 510 north from Pickerel Pond over the camp road to connect with the access route on the County Road.
